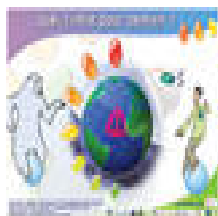


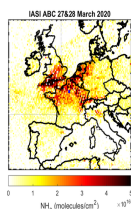

Exhibition: "Which climate for the future?"

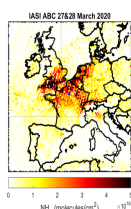

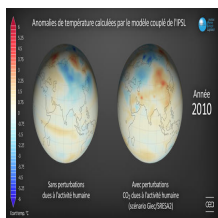
Air pollution during the COVID-19 pandemic as seen by satellite
